### What to Expect?

Your resume will be screened for a match with current job postings -- bring copies! If you are not matched on the day of the event, you will move forward with a 1-on-1 appointment with a Job Seeker Consultant. Arrive at least 15 minutes before the Event start time. Plan to stay for 2 1/2 to 3 hours. No children please.

### Who Qualifies?

Open to residents of South Central CT. Those not matched immediately may move on to a 1-on-1 appointment to determine other training and job development services available to you. Eligibility varies. Be sure to let staff know if you are collecting Unemployment Insurance, have exhausted your benefits or are certified as a Dislocated Worker. You may be asked to provide information on household size and income.
