The CTWorks Career Express was made available to former employees of Mortgage Lenders Network and Anthem Blue Cross. Workforce Alliance of New Haven and the CT. Department of Labor to operate an Employment Assistance Program for the over 900 displaced workers previously with Mortgage Lenders Network and 280 from Anthem. The main objective of this program is to be a bridge that links job seekers and employers.

In recent weeks, the Career Express, which is fully equipped with computers and internet, stopped at Chevrolet Theater in Wallingford and the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Cromwell.

Job seekers can look through employment listings, receive professional help in creating or updating resumes, and sign up for a variety of workshops that are held at CTWorks Career Centers throughout the state.
